

Child and Youth Healthy Living Initiative Distribution 2023

Upper Nicola Band will provide \$200 for each child ages 0-18, that is registered as a UNB Member, and or lives on reserve. Payments will be made on December 20, 2023

Funds are meant to assist in paying for extra curricular activities. **Examples:** sports and equipment, pow wow regalia supplies, music lessons or equipment, dance lessons or equipment, hunting of fishing supplies, educational material or supplies, baby equipment or supplies, birthday or Christmas presents.

Eligibility

- Children born in 2005 or later,

Upper Nicola October 31, 2023, Tribunal Committee appointed, and Special Election for Three (3) Councillors called

- On July 29, 2023, Jeremy Tom resigned his position as elected Councillor,
- On September 4, 2023, Eva Tom resigned her position as elected Councillor.
- On October 23, 2023, Kayla Boston resigned her position as elected Councillor.

As a result of the three resignations, there are three elected Councillor positions vacant.

Under the UNB Custom Election Regulations dated February 3, 2020 (the Regulations) Part 21-Vacancies 3. In the case of a removal from office or a vacancy of the Council position with c) more than one year before the date of the next scheduled Election, the general membership at the earliest GBM shall provide a motion to call for a Special Election and shall be held in accordance with these Regulations to fill the vacancy.

Under the Regulations Part 19 - Special Elections

- In the event of a special election or a by election the same process as General Elections apply. It must be clearly stated it is a Special Election.
- 2. At a General Band Meeting, the Members will decide the Election Schedule and Timelines.

The term of the previous Tribunal Committee expired on June 29, 2023. As a result, we are issuing a Call for Tribunal Committee Members.

At the October 25, 2023, General Band Meeting, the following motions were passed:

It was moved and seconded to appoint the following people to the Tribunal Committee:

- 2. Woman: Emily Payou
- 3. Man: Ernie Ducharme
- 4. UNB member with a basic understanding of Syilx Language; Maynard McRae Jr
- **5.** Person: Diana Boston

Carolyn's degree in counselling is from the University of Northern British Columbia (UNBC). She currently resides in Williams Lake, BC.
