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Purpose

Upper Nicola Band (UNB) is seeking proposals from interested Consultants to assist with facilitation of an Upper Nicola Band Essential Services Strategic Planning Session. Contract will include:

- 1. Pre-facilitation orientation of the community, vision of the Upper Nicola Band, current state of UNB plans and priorities.
- 2. Facilitation of a two-day session Essential Services Strategic Planning Session. June 6 & 7, 2024 Merritt, BC. (tbc)
- 3. Final Deliverable will be the UNB Essential Services Strategy, with Action Plan for UNB. (By July 7, 2024).

Background

Upper Nicola Band, of the syilx (Okanagan) Nation, with a membership of approximately one thousand members. Upper Nicola is located 45 km east of Merritt and 90 km south of Kamloops, British Columbia, Canada. Upper Nicola has eight reserves located near Nicola Lake and Douglas Lake. Upper Nicola's two main residential communities are nłqiłəmlx Nicola Lake (IR #1), and Spaxomin (Douglas Lake) .The reserves comprise approximately 31,000 acres that span a range of fifty kilometers along Highway 5A and the Douglas Lake Road.

We have four Departments that all provide essential services to our members: health, social development, Headstart and education. We receive funding from Federal and Provincial Governments to implement these services.

Within the last five years, we have added two additional departments: Kwu StemtimA? Nsyilxcen language to support areas that have been identified as community priorities.

More recently we are working to implement our syilx ways of being, through the implementation of our 13 Moon Curriculum.

Finally, UNB is recipient of a class action suit regarding the loss of culture and language. We will receive sustainable funding over 20 years (tbc), to compensate for the loss of culture and language. In the 2024-25 year, we are responsible for developing a plan on how we will utilize funds.

While we do our best to implement our community plans, programs, and service areas, we realize that we need to improve co-ordination our efforts, We are finding that we experiencing overlap of services, while at the same time, there may be gaps in service delivery.

We would like to have Departments understand what each department currently does, identify where the overlaps and gaps are. We want to plan for service delivery for UN members that will:

- Ensure all age cohorts are covered: Prenatal, 0-6, 7-12, 13-19, 20-29, 30 59, 60+
- incorporate our syilx ways of being

• empower UN members to take an active role to be responsible for their wellbeing, and UN to be there as a support.
