Construction of the 23,000ft² building began in May 2024, at Lot 8-1, IR 1 Nicola Lake.

Construction has been underway 8 months. The footprint of the building is prepared, mass timber will begin to be erected, and prefabricated walls are being installed. We will be in lock up stage by March 2025.

One of the outbuildings, the Maintenance Building is under construction and is projected to be completed by February 2025.

Substantial completion is projected for December 15, 2025: 11 months away!


We are working to award work to Artists for 4 pieces of art on the site. Stay tuned next month, for update on this!

Eligible Patients

Register yourself, family members, and/or persons in your care if each person resides within the Merritt local health area

Ineligible Patients

Persons who already have a family doctor or nurse practitioner in Merritt **OR** do not currently live in the Merritt area OR do not have a personal health number* *PHN is found on the BC Services Card

What Happens Next

You will be contacted as soon as a provider has capacity to accept you as a patient. We are not able to provide an estimated timeline or any indication of your position on the list but it is expected to take some time and your patience is appreciated.
